In 2003, Rick was asked by his contemporaries to help lead a camp visioning team for the Southeast Jurisdiction of the United Methodist Church. The ideas and vision (now called “The Seven Foundation Documents of Christian Camping” developed by this group were presented to the annual meeting of the United Methodist Camp Directors and won universal approval.**

**Most recently, Rick has established an EcoEternity Forest at Camp Highroad becoming the first such forest in the United States. Rick is an Eagle Scout and has been awarded the Cross- and –Flame Award and the Torch Award by the United Methodist Church for his work with youth in the community.**

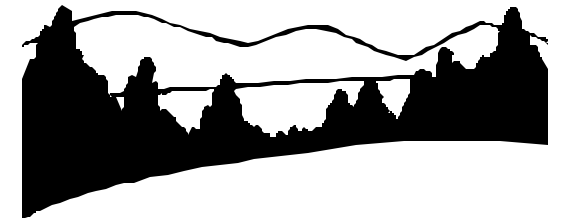
