A NOTE TO OUR GUESTS: Camp Bethel is the outdoor ministry (camp & conference center) of the Virlina District Church of the Brethren. Founded in 1927, Camp Bethel is "sacred ground" for thousands of persons who find sanctuary in these 470 beautiful, peaceful acres. Our primary mission is as a Christian Summer Camp, so our lodging and bathing facilities are generally rustic and simple. We welcome your use of our camp facilities for your event. Take comfort in simplicity and bring a spirit of self-sufficiency for your stay. ***These prices represent discounts of 15%-80% for members of Virlina District Church of the Brethren churches and their sponsored groups for lodging and facility rentals.**



TERMS OF USE: Overnight Lodging = 2pm-12noon. **Day Use** = 8am-5pm. Please read **Notes** on the back of this page. **Deposits** are noted in each section and are required to reserve facilities and services. Your deposit counts toward your final bill. For lodging and meals, children ages 4-12 receive 50% discount, and children 0-3 are free. Additional guidelines and policies are detailed in the RENTAL AGREEMENT. Creative arrangements are available for families, week-end and week-long camps, retreats, conferences, parties, reunions, banquets, weddings and all your event ideas; www.CampBethelVirginia.org. For all lodging, bring your own linens, dishes, cookware, and utensils.

LODGING: Cost is fee per night or the fee per person, whichever is greater. For all lodging, the DEPOSIT to reserve the facility is the fee per night. For facility locations, see enclosed site map.

Retreat Center	Comfortable 1970s lodge; sleeps up to 16 in 7 bedrooms. Full kitchen (<i>bring your own linens, dishes, cookware & utensils</i>), 30-person meeting room w/ fireplace & amenities for a small conference; 3 tables; 20 padded chairs. Each 2 bedrooms share a bath; 14 twin beds; 1 full bed. Accessible.	14 twin, 1 full. (6 rooms with 2 twin; 1 room w/ 2 twin & 1 full)	The greater of \$220/night or \$22/person/night
Heritage Lodge	Our largest lodge with four large bedrooms, each with its own bathroom & showers. Large 60-person meeting room with fireplace, couches & amenities; 6 large round tables; 1 rectangle 6' table; 60 chairs. Full fridge in room 1; 2 sinks & kitchenettes in meeting room; microwave; coffee maker. Air-conditioned for hot weather; warm and comfortable in winter. A-Frame Lodges: Bethel Lodge, Pineview Lodge	Classic 1960s A-frame lodges with 3 separated bedrooms each. Each lodge has a full kitchen, one full bathroom, and comfortable, eclectic couches. Bethel Lodge has the larger meeting space, suitable for 20 with 2 meeting/dining tables, 12+ chairs. Heated for winter use. Cozy and comfortable.	12 in Pineview, 13 in Bethel; all singles or bunk beds	The greater of \$120/night or \$20/person/night
Cottages: Blue Birds' Nest, Carolina Haven, Forest Lodge, Whippoorwill Wildwood	Efficiency cottages ideal for families, small groups or youth groups year round. Each is equipped with a kitchenette, 2 full bathrooms, 4 folding chairs and a small table, electric outlets & attic fans. Heated for winter use. Forest Lodge is a fully accessible cottage with couch, full kitchen and 1 bathroom. Whippoorwill has full kitchen and 1 bathroom.	14 each in bunks. Comfort Cabins: Daleville, Friendship Haven, Pleasant View	Year-round, one-room cabins. Ideal for groups. Heated for winter use. Electric outlets & attic fans. Next-door to the Deer Field Center Bathhouse, Gym and Conference Room. Pleasant View is a partially accessible cabin.	14 each in bunks	The greater of \$45/night or \$15/person/night
Seasonal Cabins: Willoro, Whispering Pines	One-room <i>vintage</i> cabins, mostly for warm weather use. Electric outlets & attic fans; next-door to seasonal bathhouse. Whispering Pines has wall-heaters in case of cold weather. Rustic, comfortable... maybe even <i>classic</i> ?	14 each in bunks	The greater of \$30/night or \$10/person/night
Stone HOP Bunk House	Stone HOP is a warm-weather bunk-house adjoining the House of Pillars Conference Room. Stone HOP can convert into a meeting room for 16-20. Electric outlets. Bathhouse within 50 yards. Great porch & view! Accessible.	16 bunks	The greater of \$30/night or \$10/person/night

CAMPING: Call ahead or e-mail to reserve an RV site. Cost is the fee per night. No deposit necessary for RV and tent camping.

RV's & Trailers	We have 2 small full (E, S, W) RV hook-up spots with shared spigots and several RV camping areas with limited hook-ups (E, W) & bathhouses. Dry-camp anywhere!	2:00pm-12:00noon \$12/night/site hook-ups \$8/night for dry RV camping.
Tents	Tent camping is popular in our Cave Trail Field with a seasonal bath-house close by, or choose a remote area.	\$8/night/tent anywhere on camp.

PICNIC SHELTERS: (Available Apr 1 through Oct 31.) *Virlina members' only special: The fee per day for shelters includes all persons. Extra donations encouraged and accepted. Deposit to reserve is the fee per day.*

Cave Trail Picnic Shelter	Accommodates up to 80 persons; open air; 8 picnic tables; fire pit; water spigot; electric; bathhouse nearby; horseshoes & pits; large activity field; small grill; bring your own charcoal.	\$70/day
Shelter-by-the-Spring Pavilion	Accommodates up to 150 persons; screened; 13 large picnic tables; 22-foot buffet table; countertops; 2 kitchen areas, stove, fridges & sinks; fireplace; bathrooms; electric; ceiling fans; horseshoes; pond; small grill; bring your own charcoal.	\$90/day
