CAMP DIRECTOR'S 2019 SUMMER CAMP SUMMARY: Our 93rd consecutive summer camp season ran from June 7 through July 26; seven exciting weeks learning how to "Let the Peace of Christ Rule." 1,062 campers participated in Resident Camps, Adventure Camps, Trips, Skills Camps, and Day Camps including 152 participants in our 3 Traveling Day Camps and 32 participants in our Family Fun nights. 93 families pre-registered for 2020 camps. Camper families gave an offering of \$2,564 toward our "Seed, Scattered and Sown" Campaign. We are blessed with excellent staff, helpful partner organizations, and dedicated volunteers who served as Chaplains, counselors and helpers. 165 children and youth received Good-As-Gold funding from Virlina congregations totaling \$42,918. DID YOU KNOW? Our April 12-13, 2019 Sounds of the Mountains Festival was our biggest ever, raising \$47,497 (net \$34,082)!

DID YOU KNOW? Ruth Mae Hess, age 88, passed away peacefully on May 19, 2019 with hospice care at her home in the Hearthstone Cottage. Ruth served at Camp Bethel through Brethren Volunteer Service 1997-2003; she continued to serve in the camp office until 2011. **DID YOU KNOW?** Camp Bethel hosted William Byrd HS Band Camp July 28-Aug 3, Camp Kesem (for kids whose parents have cancer or have died from cancer) August 4-9, and Salem HS Band Camp August 11-17, and we will again in 2020.

DID YOU KNOW? In 2019, Camp Bethel hosted 264 guest groups or events on 49 of 52 possible weeks and weekends!

DID YOU KNOW? From June 15, 2017 through March 5, 2018, 70 families and 8 churches/groups contributed \$10,010 to Camp Bethel in memory of Alton and Mildred Hipps, which the family designated for new metal roofing on Bethel Lodge. AND The Fellowship Class at Oak Grove CoB donated funds for new metal roofing on Pineview. AND the new roofs were added on April 30, 2019!

DID YOU KNOW? Benches or bridges make great Eagle Scout projects! Half the Spring Pond benches were rebuilt by Alex Gomez in 2015, and the other half were rebuilt by Zach Ramo in fall 2017. 16 new portable benches were built by Terry Lively in 2018-19.

DID YOU KNOW? Even with vigorous conservation efforts, 1 year of electricity at Camp Bethel costs over \$51,000, (less if winter is mild). **DID YOU KNOW?** On August 19, 2019, Barry LeNoir began his 18th year as your Camp Director.

DID YOU KNOW? Total campers in Camp Bethel's summer programs: 1998 = 580; 2008 = 876; 2018 = 1144; 2019 = 1062.

DID YOU KNOW? Our 25th annual Benefit Golf Tournament and Dinner was held August 21, 2019. 104 golfers, plus 28 Sponsors and Donors raised \$15,753 for Camp Bethel, (plus \$1 extra dollar coin found on Hole #13). Date for 2020 is September 23 (Wed).
