HOST DUTIES:

1. Change front dry-erase boards & directional signs. Consider 2nd board at office stop sign & 3rd board at Ark intersection (for new guests).
2. At each reserved facility, place Welcome Sign into clip, place Welcome Packet (w/ maps) inside facility, turn on porch light. Unlock doors.
3. Sweep or Blow all leaves and debris off of doorstep/stoop/porch. Sweep cobwebs off of front entrance/light/door.
4. Check interior for bugs (windowsills) and general tidiness.
5. Turn on outside lights on poles, old shop, Gym, etc. in areas the group is using/staying.
6. Each guest has your phone number to call if needed, so have your phone ON and charged ready to receive calls. You will not recognize their numbers, so please answer all calls.
7. Around 7:30 on their arrival night, tour through campus to reserved facilities and GREET the guests. Ensure they found their Welcome Packet and show them where your phone number is on the paperwork
8. ****MEALS**** If we're serving, be present in Ark 20 minutes before each group's FIRST meal to provide instructions, AND to see if Daniel needs help.
9. **AFTER GROUPS LEAVE:** Turn off lights, close doors & windows, check faucets & fans, remove trash, paperwork & L&F. Heat OFF in buildings with water. Turn OFF outside lights around camp and turn off the Gym lights.
