
Please discuss/share ALL this information with your team members before Wednesday.

1. **Please pre-pay for Mulligans and/or any fees due** online at [www.CampBethelVirginia.org/golf](http://www.CampBethelVirginia.org/golf) BEFORE Wednesday 11:00am. Mulligans are on the Honor System, \$5 each, 2 per player (\$10), max 8 per team (\$40). Purchasing the \$40 maximum Mulligans per team is a big help to Camp Bethel. If you must pay in person, please arrange for just ONE team member to turn in payments due and/or Mulligans. At check-in we accept cash, check (payable to Camp Bethel), or credit card.
2. From 11:00am-12:15pm, enjoy your boxed lunches with a big sub sandwich, broccoli salad, chips, 2 chocolate chip cookies, and drinks. Choose from (A) Chicken w/ bacon and ranch, (B) Smoked Turkey, or (C) Veggie Sub. Drinks include bottled water and various sodas. Eat under the pavilion, or tailgate at your car, or eat on your cart prior to play.
3. ONE team member get 4 paper programs and 4 sleeves of balls for your players. Tees are free if needed. We also have lots of FREE used and "vintage" balls available for pickup. List of teams/players and cart/hole # will be posted under the pavilion and on your cart.
4. Range balls are available FREE at the range beginning at 11:00am. 12:30 "shotgun" start. Captain's Choice; a noncompetitive day of fun and fellowship.
5. In recent years, we've heard from players and sponsors that random Door Prizes, while appreciated, are an unnecessary added expense for this fundraising event. If you feel that we should provide door prizes for 2023, please contact us to help recruit businesses and individuals to provide gifts and "swag," and email us if you have opinions or questions.
6. Discuss with your team what your Health protocols will be for your team and cart. (Ex: Whether or not someone may choose to wear a facemask.)
7. When play is complete, PLEASE HELP: Bring your final hole sponsor sign & stakes back to the wood boxes under the picnic pavilion at Ashley. Separate signs from the stakes. Thank you! **If you want your team to compete for 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place**, total your team score onto ONE labeled scorecard, then bring your scorecard to the box on the check-in table under the picnic pavilion at Ashley. We will email each team leader on Thursday, September 29 with the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place team results, as well as the overall fundraising totals for the event, and we will mail the team prizes to the team leader. 8. Sadly, this will be my final Golf Tournament with you! After 21 years as your Camp Director, I will be departing Camp Bethel after June 2023.
