4:00 - Staff Check-in (4:00pm, Monday) – APCs and SPC meet arriving staff at Camp entrance as they drive in and perform health-screenings before they exit the vehicle. Unit Coordinators greet screened staff at Office and A-Frames, help them unload gear into assigned housing. After unload, park cars in the Ark Lot where a Coordinator will greet them and walk back with them to A Frames. Get-to-know-you’s and Icebreakers until all staff have arrived.
