**Camp Bethel facilities are available according to the following guidelines:**

1. No one with a fever or symptoms of COVID-19 or known exposure to a COVID-19 case in the last 14 days, is permitted on site at Camp Bethel.
2. Continue to practice physical distancing with other people.
3. Tents and RVs must maintain a minimum of 20 feet between units.
4. Only select bathhouses, shelters, and pavilions are available. *See re-opening schedule below.*
5. No physical sharing of recreation equipment unless it is cleaned and disinfected.
6. Only registered guests are permitted on site overnight. Day hikers, walkers, and cyclists are permitted on site during daylight hours. Do NOT enter facilities you have not reserved.
7. We strongly encourage EVERYONE to wear face coverings when anywhere near other people.
8. No gatherings of greater than 50 people in one location, and practice physical distancing with others.
9. Bring and use hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes in and around your reserved facility or campsite to clean and disinfect high contact areas and hard surfaces, including door knobs/handles, dining tables/chairs, light switches, handrails, restrooms, floors, furniture, appliances, and equipment.
10. Wash hands frequently inside your facility or at your campsite.

**Tentative "Re-Opening" Schedule:** *(Schedule may change, pending decisions by the Commonwealth of Virginia.)*

- June 14, 2020: Pineview A-frame Cottage, Bethel Lodge A-frame, Shelter-by-the-Spring.
- June 21, 2020: Cave Trail Shelter, Cave Trail Bathhouse, Cave Trail field camping.
- June 28, 2020: Front Creekside Campsites, Pool Bathhouse. *(Note: the Pool is closed for 2020.)*
- July 5, 2020: All other facilities, pending reservations.

**Stop the spread of COVID-19:**

- ✓ Stay at least 6 feet apart (2 arms' length) from other people.
- ✓ Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash and wash your hands.
- ✓ When near other people, wear a cloth face mask covering your nose and mouth.
- ✓ Do not touch your eyes, nose, and mouth, and avoid touching your face.
- ✓ Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

- ✓ Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
