A NOTE TO OUR GUESTS: Camp Bethel is the outdoor ministry (camp and conference center) of the Virlina District Church of the Brethren. Founded in 1927, Camp Bethel is "sacred ground" for thousands of persons who find sanctuary in these 470 peaceful acres. Our primary mission is as a Christian Summer Camp, so our facilities are generally rustic and simple. Take comfort in simplicity and bring a spirit of self-sufficiency for your stay. **These prices represent discounts of 15%-80% for Virlina District Church of the Brethren churches and their sponsored events and groups for lodging and rentals.**

TERMS OF USE: **Lodging & Camping** = 2:00pm-12:00noon. **Shelters & Conference Rooms** = 8:00am-5:00pm. *Please read NOTES on the back of this page.* **Deposits** are noted in each section and are required to reserve facilities and services. Your deposit counts toward your final bill. For lodging and meals, children ages 3-12 receive 50% discount, and infants/toddlers 0-2 are free. Your invoice for lodging and rentals will reflect the rates of the year (Sept 1-Aug 31) in which you pay your reservation deposit. Your invoice for meals and programming will reflect the rates of the year (Sept 1-Aug 31) in which you hold your event. Rules, policies, and recommendations are detailed in the RENTAL AGREEMENT. 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| Retreat Center | Comfortable 1970s lodge; sleeps up to 17/18 in 7 bedrooms. Full kitchen (<i>bring your own linens, dishes, cookware & utensils</i>), 30-person meeting room w/ fireplace & amenities for a small conference; 3 tables; 20 padded chairs. Each 2 bedrooms share a bath; 15 twin beds, 1 bunkbed. Accessible. | 15 twin, 2 bunks. Rooms 1-6 = 2 twin; Rm 7 = 3 twin, 2 bunks | \$25/person/night with minimum \$250/night. |
| Heritage Lodge | Our largest lodge with four large bedrooms, each with its own bathroom & showers. 56-person meeting room with fireplace, couches; 6 large round tables; 1 rectangle 6' table; 56 chairs; 2 kitchenettes (mini-fridges, sinks, 2 stove-tops); microwave; 2 coffee makers. Full fridge in room 1; Heated and air-conditioned. Partially accessible. | 56 in bunks 14 people in each of 4 bedrooms | \$22/person/night with minimum \$440/night. |
| A-Frame Lodges: Bethel Lodge, Pineview Lodge | Classic 1960s A-frame lodges with 3 separated bedrooms each. Each lodge has a full kitchen, one full bathroom, and comfortable, eclectic couches. Bethel Lodge has the larger meeting space, suitable for 20 with 2 meeting/dining tables, 12+ chairs. Heated, plus window-unit air-conditioners. Cozy and comfortable. | 12 in Pineview, 11 in Bethel; all singles or bunk beds | \$20/person/night with minimum \$120/night. |
| Cottages: Bandage Box, Blue Birds' Nest, Carolina Haven, Forest Lodge, Wildwood | Efficiency cottages ideal for families, small groups or youth groups year round. Each is equipped with a kitchenette, 2 full bathrooms, 4 folding chairs and a small table, electric outlets & attic fans. Heated, plus window-unit air-conditioner. Bandage Box has full kitchen and 1 bathroom, plus a large front deck. Forest Lodge is a partially accessible cottage with full kitchen and 1 bathroom. | 14 each in bunks (12 in Bandage Box and Carolina Haven) | \$20/person/night with minimum \$100/night. |
| Comfort Cabins: Daleville, Friendship Haven, Pleasant View | Year-round, one-room cabins. Ideal for groups. Heated, plus window-unit air-conditioner. Electric outlets & attic fans. Next-door to the Deer Field Center Bathhouse, Gym and Conference Room. Pleasant View is a partially accessible cabin. | 14 each in bunks | \$15/person/night with minimum \$60/night. |
| Seasonal Cabins: Willoro, Whispering Pines | One-room <i>vintage</i> cabins, mostly for warm weather use. Heated, plus window-unit air-conditioner. Electric outlets & attic fans; next-door to seasonal bathhouse (Apr-Oct). Rustic, comfortable... maybe even <i>classic</i> ? | 14 each in bunks | \$15/person/night with minimum \$45/night. |
| Stone HOP Bunk House | Stone HOP is a bunk-house adjoining the House of Pillars Conference Room which can convert into a meeting room for 16-20. Heated, plus window-unit air-conditioner. Electric outlets. Bathhouse within 50 yards; toilets in HOP Conference Room. Great porch & view! Accessible. <i>Must also reserve House of Pillars Conf. Room (see pg 2) in order to lodge in Stone HOP.</i> | 14 in bunks | \$15/person/night with minimum \$45/night or plus fee for HOP. |

CAMPING: *Call ahead or e-mail to reserve an RV site. Cost is the fee per night. No deposit necessary for RV and tent camping. 2:00pm-12:00noon*

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| RV's & Trailers | We have 2 small full (E, S, W) RV hook-up spots with shared spigots and our Front Creekside RV Sites 1-8 with limited hook-ups (E, W) & Pool Bathhouse nearby. Dry-camping is also available. | \$15/night/site hook-ups \$10/night for dry RV camping. |
| Tents | Tent camping is popular in our Cave Trail Field with a seasonal bath-house close by. | \$10/night/tent anywhere on camp. |

PICNIC SHELTERS: (Available Apr 1 through Oct 31.) **Virlina members' only special:** *The fee per day for shelters includes all persons. Extra donations encouraged and accepted. | Shelter-by-the-Spring Pavilion | Up to 150 persons; screened; 13 large picnic tables; 22-foot buffet table; 2 kitchen areas w/ stove, fridges, sinks; bathrooms; electric; ceiling fans; horseshoe pits; pond; small grill; bring your own charcoal.* | \$150 per day all inclusive. <i>Extra donations encouraged.</i> |

| House of Pillars Conference Room | Up to 100 persons; 10 tables; 80 chairs; couches; fridge; bathrooms; water fountain; electric outlets; air-conditioned; accessible. Dry marker board; newsprint w/ easel; lectern. | \$140 per day all inclusive. <i>Extra donations encouraged.</i> |
| Deer Field Conference Hall | Up to 350 persons; 350 chairs; rentable stage & tables; bathrooms; accessible; \$200-\$400 set up fee, depending on requested set up. Dry marker board; newsprint w/ easel. Includes Deer Field Meeting Room. | \$300 per day all inclusive. <i>Extra donations encouraged.</i> |
| Deer Field Meeting Room | Up to 40 persons; 40 chairs; 4 tables; couches; bathrooms; accessible. | \$60 per day all inclusive. <i>Extra donations encouraged.</i> |
| Ark Dining Hall as a Meeting Hall | Up to 200 persons; tables/chairs; accessible; converts to dining room. 2 dry marker boards; Newsprint w/ easel; lectern. Air-conditioned during hot weather. <i>Only available by special arrangement when no food services are reserved for other groups.</i> | Call for prices |
| Bethel Lodge Meeting Room | Up to 20 persons; 2 couches; 1 bathroom; 2 tables, 20+ chairs. Dry marker board; newsprint w/ easel. See LODGING description. <i>Only available by special arrangement.</i> | Call for prices |
| Heritage Meeting Room | Up to 60 persons; couches; 1 rectangular 6' table; 6 round tables & 60 chairs; full fridge; 2 kitchettes; fireplace; 4 bathrooms; accessible. | Retreat Center Meeting Room | Up to 30 persons; 3 tables & 20 chairs; fireplace; full kitchen; accessible. Dry marker board; newsprint w/ easel; lectern. See LODGING description. <i>Only available by special arrangement.</i> | Call for prices |

FOOD SERVICES Camp Bethel meals are available August through May, Breakfast 8:00am, Lunch 12:30pm, and Dinner 5:30pm. Deviation from times is possible if you are the first group requesting meals, but you must let us know so we can confirm adjustments. Buffet Style or Family Style is at the discretion of our kitchen. For our kitchen to prepare meals, total group size must be 20 persons or more. This minimum is often met by multiple groups taking meals on the same dates. You may request meals with fewer than 20 persons, but you must pay for minimum 20 persons. If Camp Bethel cannot accommodate meal requests for any reason your group will be contacted as soon as possible prior to your visit. With minimum 14 day advance notice, our kitchen can accommodate vegetarian, gluten-free, and nut-free dietary restrictions. **You must provide your final meal count AND any dietary restriction requests at least 14 days prior to your arrival, and this amount will be the minimum number of meals for your invoice.** The minimum deposit for meals is 50% of the fees for your reserved meals. Your invoice for meals will reflect the rates of the year (Sept 1-Aug 31) in which you hold your event. Contact our office if your group is interested in a private banquet or special event.

SWIMMING POOL is available Memorial Day to Labor Day on Saturdays and Sundays 12:00-5:00 with advance reservation. Deposit to reserve is your total pool fee, due 2 weeks prior to event. Children must be accompanied by an adult. Fee includes 1 lifeguard.

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| Group rate - 1 lifeguard provided | 0-2 hours = \$75 | 2-4 hours = \$125 | 4-6 hours = \$175 | Outside regular hours or days = Add \$75 |
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PROGRAMMING & OTHER SERVICES: Deposit to reserve programming is full cost, due 2 weeks prior to your event. You may reserve programming with fewer than 8 persons, but you must pay for minimum persons and your invoice will reflect the rates of the year in which you hold your event.
